The goal of TBSC is to instill in its participants, the ideals of good sportsmanship, honesty, loyalty, courage, discipline and respect for authority. Also, that the youth of the area will grow to be citizens whose adult lives will reflect those values. These objectives will be reached by providing the highest quality of supervision and competitive games. The supervisors shall bear in mind at all times that the attainment of exceptional athletic skill or the winning of games is secondary to the players' well being. It is the philosophy of TBSC to have its coaches teach players all aspects of the game of soccer.

1. Coaches and managers will treat players, parents and spectators with respect. They will not use vulgar or profane language while in the presence of their players.
2. Coaches and managers will treat referees with respect. The coach and manager will be held responsible for the behavior of their players, parents and spectators. In the event that a coach, manager, player, parent or spectator is ejected from a game, the coach or manager shall escort that person from the field. The ejected person shall leave the field and have no further contact with the team until the game is finalized. There shall be a two game suspension (current game plus next game) for any person ejected. Furthermore, TBSC reserves the right to add to that suspension if deemed necessary. A referee's act of ejection is by his discretion alone and is not open to appeal. The suspended person has a right to appeal the added suspension time only. This appeal shall be submitted to the Referee Assignor and the President of TBSC within 48 hours.
3. No person shall be permitted to use tobacco products, alcohol (do not come to the field with alcohol on your breath), or any illegal substance while on, or at, the field. This policy is in effect at all TBSC sponsored events, including practices and games, both official and unofficial. Coaches and managers will be responsible for enforcing this policy as well as other club officials.

NOTE: Any person violating this policy shall be prohibited from attending TBSC events for the remainder of the season. THERE WILL BE NO DEVIATIONS FROM THIS POLICY.

4. By endorsement of this Code of Conduct, the signer agrees to abide by all rules governing TBSC, including a Washington State Patrol background investigation and the participation in all mandatory coaches' clinics/meetings.
